

Arriving for lessons:

- I know it's obvious, but just to say, please don't come to the Dojo if you or someone you've been in contact with seems to be unwell with possible symptoms, OR, if your Year Group/class at school has been sent home to isolate.
- Children will need to arrive in their suits, and in some kind of slip on/off footwear, (or crocs, wellies etc), as there will be limited time at drop off to fiddle with shoes. (Please take coats & shoes back to your car with you). They will also **need to be wearing socks** as they will be training in socks for the foreseeable future.
- Although the toilet will be available, please try to ensure that your child uses the toilet before coming to the Dojo. (Also, just to confirm, the changing rooms will be closed).
- Please remain in your car until no more than 5 minutes before your lesson is due to start, in order to allow the previous class to exit. (Remember the car parking machine though, don't arrive too early into the car park! We understand there is about 20 minutes grace period from entering the car park to needing to put your number in the machine).
- There is only room for 2 parents in the reception area, so I'm afraid you will need to wait outside and come to the doorway one at a time.
- Move around the reception area in an anti-clockwise circle only: so, on entering walk past the shelving rack, the car park machine, the register, and then the sanitizer by the coffee machine. At this point, if you're leaving, leave by walking past the wall with the noticeboards on. (We'll open up both doors to help with this).
- **You MUST tick the register for Track and Trace purposes!!!** Unlike how we normally do it, if you have to come on a different day to your usual class, please add your name to that day's register. If you have any doubt that we don't have your up to date phone numbers, please email them – with your student's name! – to me so I can double check.
- Only 1 adult per student family to come into the Dojo, and if you'll be waiting in the Parents' area (see next point) for your child, you'll need a mask please.
- We are limited on numbers who can be in the Dojo according to our square footage. This means that Little Dragon parents can stay in the building during the lesson in case their child needs assistance, but for KK1 (6pm) children and above I'm afraid you will need to return to your car to wait for the lesson to end. (Or to the pub maybe – they do sell coffee etc).
- Once they're in the building, students will head straight onto the mats with their mitts and their water bottle - we've rearranged all of the mats into different coloured areas, so each student will have their own defined area, with their own 'bully'. Because they will be taking their drinks on to the mats with them, we do need to request that they **only bring water** on with them to avoid sticky drips happening.
- If you need to speak to myself/Anita or Sensei, send your child on to the mats and then wait near our offices; we'll catch up with you asap.

Collecting at the end of the lesson....

- No earlier than the last 5 minutes before the lesson ends, come to the doorway, and at the end of lesson we'll invite you to remind us who you're collecting, and we'll send that child straight off the mat to you.
- Again, no more than 2 parents in the reception area to ensure distancing, so you'll need to move out again swiftly please.
